## Shiitake Inoculated Mushroom Logs

2 Sessions

This basic introduction to mushroom cultivation will cover several species of gourmet mushrooms. Techniques on how to inoculate (plant) using different spawn that will be covered in the class, will allow home gardeners to grow mushrooms perennially. The 2nd portion of the class will be hands on, where participants will inoculate a mushroom log you get to take home, leave them outside year-round, producing 4-6 years, your mushroom logs will be ready to fruit in 6-18 months.
