Brian was subbing for a friend at Pla Mor Lanes in Montgomery.


Tyler, a 2017 Tri-City United graduate, was subbing for a friend at Bowlerama in Des Moines, Iowa.

"I was bowling with my friend, Tyler Cardar, and we just kept talking about other stuff--our physics homework and other stuff--because if you start thinking about it a lot, you start getting more nervous."

But, the strikes kept coming, and Tyler logged his first, sanctioned 300 game.

"I've had a 300 in practice or while I'm bowling on my own before, but this was my first official 300 from ABC (American Bowling Congress)," he explained. "It was
