

Foggy streets mark passage into a wet spring









The National Weather Service issued a dense fog advisory for the Twin Cities on March 14. Visibility was down to zero in southern and central Minnesota. Warmer air, piles of snow everywhere and a misty rain combined to shroud Northeast in a dense fog for most of the day. As if poor visibility wasn't enough, icy, potholed streets made driving treacherous.

Center left: The benches at Boom Island Park remained empty as fog rolled along the Mississippi River. (Photo by Mark Peterson)


