## Mid 30s and partly cloudy for our weekend

Temperatures were fairly mild over the weekend for this time of the year. We experienced temperatures in the 30s and even into the 40s on Saturday.

A couple of weak disturbance pushed across the region on Monday. One of those disturbances moved in from the northwest and other from the

southwest. Temperatures were warm enough for most of the precipitation to fall in the form of rain.

A more potent system is to expected arrive for the mid-week. This system will be one to keep an eye on as it could bring some heavier rainfall, and potentially some snowfall to parts of

Minnesota. Right now it looks like southern Minnesota into eastern Minnesota could see the largest potential for accumulating snowfall.

We should see temperatures near average for much of the week. However, on Thursday temperatures are projected to be below average and then rebound

on Friday and into the weekend.

Have a great midweek and keep an eye to the sky.

Weather history: On this date in 1953 records show that "freezing rain hit part of Minnesota." Telephone wires were downed as some spots had three inches of ice accumulation.

Weather facts: Did you know that freezing rain "falls through a shallow layer of cold air?" This layer of air is at 32 degrees near the surface. When the rain becomes "supercooled it can freeze on contact with roads, bridges, trees and power lines."
