### Virtual Soil & Water Management Field Day

Lamberton, Minn. - Soil researchers, stakeholders, Water Management - NW and water management and conservation are the focus of the 7th Soil and Water Management Field Day, which is being held virtually on Thursday, August 13. This program will begin at 9:00 a.m. with presentations and question and answer sessions and conclude at noon. The webinar is free, but participants must preregister online at https:// swroc.cfans.umn.edu/7thsoil-water. An email address is required to register, and participants can join the webinar from a computer, tablet or phone.

The 7th Soil and Water Management Field Day is an inter-institutional event designed to highlight progress on soil and water management research. The objective of this field day is to convene farmers,

and practitioners to interact MN drainage and phosphoon issues related to soil and water management for productivity and environmental enhancement. blood I know, has washed me white as snow. And in God's Word I'm told, I'll walk the streets of gold. Oh wonderful, wonderful day, He washed my sins away!"

The Wuhan virus has caused much consternation, inconvenience, sickness, death and heartache across our

The red page points out that Jesus died on the cross and shed His blood for our sin.

"But God commends His love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

(Romans 5:8)

The white page pictures a clean heart after one places his faith in Jesus. "Purge me with hyssop and I shall be clean; wash me and I shall be whiter than snow." (Psalm 51:7)

The gold page points to heaven, the golden city, the future home of all who are in Christ.

"In My Father's house are many mansions... I go to prepare a place for you." (John 14:2)

The green cover speaks of the new life one has in Christ—forgiven of sin, it is a life of peace, joy and growth. "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ." (2 Peter 3:18)
