Otters stop Green Wave running game in 19-6 win

Fergus Falls came into town last Friday and were able to shutdown the Green Wave running attack and then hold on for the 19-6 win.

"We really felt like, we could run the ball on these guys. And we just weren't able to do that," says Green Wave Head Coach Ryan Kasowski. "And we took too many sacks and things like that are tough to overcome."

After a scoreless first quarter the Otters took a 6-0 lead on a Ethan Olson to Abel Aho 34 yard pass in the second quarter.

Neither team was able to gain any traction in the third quarter and in the fourth the Otters took advantage of a fumble recovery scoring to make it 12-0.

With time against them Senior High came alive and scored on a Nick Vargas to Nathan Willett 89 yard pass play to cut the lead to 12-6. On the next of fensive play Parker Jacobs would break free giving the Otters a 19-6 lead.

Senior High was not done and took the ball down field and were turned away by a nice defensive play by Cody Nor-

gren to break-up a pass to Willet in the end zone and then an interception by Cole Zierden that iced the game.

"I really thought our defense came to play," says Coach Kasowski. "I think, towards the end we were on the field so much defensively that we started to wear down a little bit and I thought fatigue set in a little bit."

This week Senior High (1-2) will host Park Rapids (0-3) in the Wave's homecoming game.
