league, he was must-watch TV. For me, it kept that love for the NBA and the love for how he competed and played.”

Sather’s team took the news hard Sunday.

“You feel the impact,” Sather said. “When it’s your time, whenever that it is, you look back and who did you get a chance to impact? You hear Billy talk about our team in Grand Forks, North Dakota. Filip (Rebraca) met him, Marko (Coudreau) met him, our guys idolize him. For some, he was their way of escaping into something they love, and they love it because of him.”

Sather plans to address the news with his team.

“There’s a few things I want them to see video-wise,” Sather said.

“One thing I read is that he was taking his kid to an AAU deal, and he was at Mass yesterday morning. That makes it human. He was going to Mass like a lot of other Catholics going to Mass. To me, those are things more important than what kind of player he was. That’s what I want our team to understand. Yeah, he was fun to watch, and wasn’t perfect in life, but man, he was in the right place when it happened spiritually. That’s a big deal to me. I think our guys need to know that because that’s bigger than a basketball game, no doubt.”

UND freshman women’s basketball player Kacie Borowicz of Roseau, Minn., said she always looked up to Bryant and tried to mimic his game.

Borowicz said a junior varsity coach for the Rams used to call her Kobe. When she got to UND, Fighting Hawks assistant coach John Motherwell called her Kobe, too.

“Devastated,” she said. “It’s crazy to think someone I’ve never met or been in contact with can have such a big impact. He was such an inspiration to me.”

UND women’s basketball coach Travis Brewster was appreciative of Bryant’s efforts to support women’s basketball.

“Being relentless about what you’re pursuing is a big deal,” Brewster said. “To have someone being relentless about growing the game is a big deal. But it’s bigger than just a game, it’s about being a person and a family man.”

‘He used to climb into the hoops’

Kobe’s Italian childhood home pays tribute

CIREGLIO, Italy — As Americans mourned NBA legend Kobe Bryant on Monday, Jan. 27, fans and friends in Italy remembered a lesser-known chapter in his life when he played in their streets as a boy while his father competed in the local basketball league.

Bryant, who died in a helicopter crash on Sunday, was six when his father Joe moved the family to Italy in 1984 to play seven seasons with four different teams in the center, south and finally the north.

The Bryant family first went to Rieti, a town in central Italy,

and then moved to Reggio Calabria, in the country’s toe, Cireglio in Tuscany, and finally to Reggio Emilia, in the north.

“We always kept two eyes on the ball and two eyes on him,” said one of his father’s teammates, Antonio Olivieri, 64.

He remembered the boy as a ball of energy when the family arrived in Rieti, about 50 miles from Rome.

“Kobe was a kid when he was here in Rieti. I remember Joe always taking him to the gym... he used to climb into the hoops while we were playing,” Olivieri told Reuters.

“When someone fell on the ground, he came onto the court with a mop to clean up,” he added.

The local team, NPC Rieti, published a photo of the young Kobe on its Twitter account. “You made us dream,” it wrote. “We are proud to have been the first to see you take to the court. We will never forget Kobe.”

In a radio interview in 2011, Bryant revealed his affection

for the country: “Italy will always be close to my heart,” he said.

His love for Italy was reflected in the names he chose for his four daughters — Gianna Maria-Onore, who died with him in Sunday’s crash, Natalia Diamante, Bianka Bella and Capri, who was born in June 2019.

Bryant was especially fond of Reggio Emilia, where he spent two years.

“I grew up here. I used to ride my bike here. There were all my friends, I have many memories, it’s special,” he said in an interview with BasketTime magazine in 2016.

“Forever one of us,” the Reggio Emilia Pallacanestro Reggiana team wrote on Twitter, posting some photos of Bryant when he played for the youth team.

“Kobe wasn’t known as an NBA star in Reggio Emilia. He was the kid that all the fans knew and saw at the arena when his father played,” said youth coach Andrea Menozzi.

Bryant’s friends in Cireglio, a small town where the family lived from 1987 to 1989, were struggling to come to terms with his death.

“One morning at 7, the doorbell rang and I saw Kobe,” said childhood friend Alessia Pierattini, 53, remembering a surprise visit from the Los Angeles Lakers superstar some seven years ago.

She showed him a photo album that she had put together full of pictures of when he was a boy taking his First Holy Communion at a local Roman Catholic Church.

“When we left the house after an hour together, people stopped their cars because they wanted to see him. He was open to everybody and took photos in the streets (with them),” she said. She added that Kobe had told her that he wanted to bring his daughters to live in Italy.

“I want them to experience what I felt as a child, a reality that does not exist in America,” he told Pierattini.

The Grand Forks-Trail Joint Water Resource District (the "District") previously declared the necessity to create, construct, operate, and maintain the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 PROJECT (the "Project") and a corresponding assessment district to finance and fund the Project under Chapter 61-16.1 of the North Dakota Century Code; the Project is described as follows:

The Project will be located within Sections 2, 11, 14, and 23 of Garfield Township in Traill County, and Sections 26, 35 and 36 of Washington Township in Grand Forks County. The Project will consist of approximately five miles of newly constructed legal drain and will include the installation of six new or improved culvert crossings. The Project will commence at the tributary of the Goose River in Section 23 of Garfield Township and will continue north for approximately three miles; the Project will cross into Section 36 of Washington Township where the Project will turn west and continue for approximately 2,750 feet into Section 35 of Washington Township; from there, the Project will run north for approximately one mile, and will cross into Section 26 of Washington Township where the project will end. The Project will include a legal lateral in Section 36 of Washington Township. The lateral will begin where the main channel of the legal drain enters Section 36 on the north side of County Road 25 and will go east for approximately 1,000 feet. The Project will include topographic surveys; hydrologic and hydraulic analysis; culvert crossing and channel design; installation of intercept drainage culverts with flap gates for adjacent field drainage; installation of riprap erosion control; roadway crossing improvements to county and township roads; purchasing of permanent and temporary right of way to accommodate the Project; utility relocations; and other items as necessary to accommodate the construction, operation, maintenance, and ownership of the Project. The Project will ultimately improve drainage for properties within the Project watershed.

As you know, the District conducted assessment district proceedings in accordance with North Dakota law regarding the proposed creation, construction, operation, and maintenance of the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 PROJECT and the corresponding assessment district. The proceedings included an assessment vote, as well as a hearing to consider the Project and the creation of the corresponding assessment district. The vote concluded and the majority of votes filed were in favor of the Project and in favor

of the creation of the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 PROJECT assessment district. With that in mind, the District entered an Order to legally and officially establish the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 PROJECT and the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 assessment district. As the next phase of the assessment district process, the District will conduct an assessment hearing to further examine benefits and assessments to those properties within the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 assessment district.

The District and its agents previously conducted a benefit analysis of the property that will benefit from the Project; the District determined the benefits of the Project to each lot, piece, or parcel of land and prepared a preliminary Assessment List to apportion the costs of constructing the Project to the benefitted properties. The Assessment List is a true and correct assessment of the property that will benefit from the Project, to the best of the District's judgment based on its investigation.

levy against the benefitted properties within the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 assessment district as necessary in accordance with North Dakota law for purposes of maintaining and operating the Project. Recognize North Dakota law currently limits the annual maintenance levy to a maximum of \$4 per acre for agricultural properties. In addition, the District cannot simply continue to levy maintenance levies continuously without utilizing the maintenance dollars for purposes of operating and maintaining the Project; in fact, North Dakota law limits the maximum amount of maintenance dollars the District may retain in the Project maintenance fund to the equivalent of six years of levies. Finally, as an additional safeguard for landowners within the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 PROJECT assessment district, by law the District can only utilize maintenance dollars levied for purposes of operating and maintaining the Project; the District cannot utilize any of those dollars for any other projects or any other purposes.

Please take notice that, in accordance with North Dakota law, the Grand Forks-Trail Joint Water Resource District will conduct an assessment hearing regarding assessments for the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 PROJECT, as required by North Dakota law, on February 24, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Grand Forks-Trail Joint Water Resource District, 102 - 1st Street SW, Hillsboro, North Dakota. At the Assessment Hearing, landowners within the THOMPSON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 assessment district may present their comments or objections regarding the proposed Assessment List and regarding individual assessments. Following the assessment hearing, the District may make any alterations in assessments it deems just and necessary to correct any errors in the Assessment List or to make modifications the District deems equitable. Please note the District must make the aggregate of all assessments equal to the total amount required from the local share to pay the entire cost of the work for the Project.
