# **SUCH A MIRACLE** Pupil helps revive tennis coach after cardiac arrest

Shortly into an early morning practice session on Court No. 2 at the DISC, the 79-year-old Laiti suffered

and looked and saw that he had fallen back off the bench. I thought first he had slipped and then I saw that he was not conscious. I ran inside and got Nikoli and he called 911." Wiens, who takes CPR classes every year in his role as Duluth East's volleyball coach, picks up the story: "They were the first ones in that morning so they were out on the courts beginning to train," he said. # **COVID-19 SCHOOL** UPDATE St. Louis County teen **COVID-19** cases rise

awhitefoot@duluthnews.com COVID-19 cases in St. Louis County teens continue to increase. Those ages 15-19 had 37 new cases over the past week. Those ages 0-4 had five new cases, ages 5-9 had 16 and ages 10-14 had 12.

COVID-19 Statewide, cases over the past week in these age groups were: ages 0-4, 312; ages 5-9, 495; ages 10-14, 767; and ages 15-19, 970.

Anyone age 16 and older is eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine in Minnesota.

The Centers for Disease Control and Preventionverified 14-day case rates per 10,000 residents around the Northland for March 7-20 were:

- ▶ 6.95 in Aitkin County.
- ▶ 14.63 in Carlton County.
- 30.13 in Cook County.
- 32.3 in Itasca County.
- ▶ 13.25 in Lake County.
- ▶ 19.29 in St. Louis County.
- ▶ 15.1 in the Duluth area. 23.2 in Central/Southern
- St. Louis County.

▶ 34.7 in Northern St. Louis County.

The 14-day case rates are used as guidance for school districts when choosing the right learning model for middle and high school students. Elementary students are allowed to return to inperson learning five days a week starting Jan. 18 regardless of these numbers. According to Essentia Health's CŎVID-19 Regional Projections dashboard, the county 14–day case rates per

# East's loss a tale of two halves

# Second-half surge lifts second-ranked Trojans past Greyhounds in state quarterfinal

rweegman@duluthnews.com OSSEO, Minn. – Duluth East and Wayzata were scheduled to play in a boys basketball regular-season finale March 13.

One day beforehand, however, the Trojans called off the game, ostensibly due to COVID-19 concerns. The Greyhounds were not happy about the late notice during a season in which they weren't able to play many Twin Cities-area teams due to the pandemic.

The teams finally got their chance to play Wednesday in a Class AAAA state tournament quarterfinal at Osseo High School.

After struggling with a fired-up East team in the first half, second-ranked Wayzata took over in the second half to win 78-69 and advance to next week's semifinal round.

"This is such a wacky year. I did not like not playing that game, that was on us, Wayzata coach Bryan Schnettler said of the cancellation. "Luckily, we got to play on a Carter Bjerke, East used its bigger stage and it was really fun for both teams."

"We knew they would create a storm and come back," said East senior center Noah Paulson, who scored a team-high 15 points. "We thought we could weather it, but they're a great team. We were happy with the way we played in the first half; we were a little loose in the second half."

With the 6-foot-8 Paulson excelling inside against 6-9 own 16-2 run in the first half to take a 30-21 lead. That It turned out to be more fun advantage stretched to 11 at 40-29 after Paulson stormed used an 18-2 run at the start the lane like a Mack truck and

Michael Kastelic and Mattie Thompson hit back-to-back 3-pointers.

Paulson's bank shot at the buzzer made it 42-36 at the break.

"We had things cooking in the first half but it's a game of runs," East coach Rhett McDonald said.

Bjerke, the Division I prospect who has as sweet of a long-range jump shot that you will find in a 6-9 post player, opened the second half with one of his three 3-pointers, and the Trojans scored the first 11 points of the half and never trailed again.

"They surprised our guys

early on," Schnettler said. "Our guys came out with a lot of passion and fire to start the second half."

While Bjerke and Camden Heide grab most of the attention, senior guard Eddie Beeninga turned in one of his best outings. Beeninga finished with a game-high 26 points.

"He's our third-leading scorer and had a great year, Schnettler said. "He has a 3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio. In the last two games he's really scored for us as teams have taken other guys away. It's not a secret to anyone that Eddie can play."

By the time the Greyhounds caught their breath they were down double digits.

"We ran out of gas," McDonald said. "We played a short number of kids. At some point, fatigue absolutely sets in. You could see that, not just in making shots, but mental errors and you saw that a lot more in the second half than the first half.

"I don't think we could have shot the ball better than we did in the first half. We knew that we'd have to shore up the defensive end, and we didn't. The fatigue impacted our defensive efficiency.

"There was no doubt that we could compete with these guys. Honestly, we just ran out of gas."

Kastelic and Zaa Buffalo each scored 13 points while Thompson contributed 11.

The Greyhounds lose five key seniors from the team, including the Minnesota Duluth-bound duo of Paulson and Thompson.

"I've been coaching these kids in the spring since they were in fifth and sixth grade," McDonald said. "A long time ago, we talked about how we're not going to be content with beating local teams. We talked about wanting to knock off the Lakeville Norths, the Wayzatas, Hopkins, Minnetonka • the blue bloods.

"What these guys were able to accomplish getting to state, competing with one of the top teams in the state, is absolutely remarkable."

As Paulson said, there will be more to recall about this season than the final score of the final game.

"We won't remember losing this game, we'll remember all the positive things that we've gone through," he said.
