Please allow me a moment to explain the reporting procedures associated with the Grand Forks Herald's "On the border" entry into the Category X.

This entry is so much more than just a basic news series. The print component (the stories you will read) are just a portion of the sum effort that went into this project.

Foremost, the Herald put together a three-part documentary video that ran in conjunction with the stores you will read. The documentary comes to about 40 minutes, with each chapter running approximately 13 minutes. Great effort went into the video portion of this project, with a team of reporters and photographers each spending multiple days in the area seeking all angles that helped tell this unique story. The project took six weeks to complete. There were multiple columns about the project and even an editorial.
