

- ★ Nicknamed "The Spin Doctor" for his signature spin move he put on defenders
- ★ Selected as 12th overall pick in the 1973 NFL Draft by the Vikings
- ★ His 8 season career consisted of 7 seasons for the Vikings (1973-79) and 1 season for the Patriots (1980)
- ★ NFL Rookie of the Year in 1973
- ★ Holds the Vikings all-time rushing record with 5,879 yards
- ★ Tied for Vikings team rushing record at 52 rushing TDs
- ★ 17 career 100-yard games
- ★ Integral part of the Vikings appearance in 3 Super Bowls
- ★ Suffered a knee injury during the 1978 season, and officially retired from pro football in 1980
- ★ Vikings inducted him into the Ring of Honor on September 30, 2007
