“I come from a long line of healers and creatives,” Facio said, noting that his mother, who passed away when he was 12, was a sonographer with a penchant for landscaping and visual design. His father, a body worker, “was sort of like a philosopher, speaking in metaphors often.

He used to tell me as a kid, ‘you have your cape Superman, now what are you going to do with it?’ He was referring to my aesthetic appearance. I was the type of kid to wear dark make-up and fishnets to school. When he saw the impact and reception of Zombie Crawl, it gave him

some relief that I found my niche. So when he passed away in 2016, I felt it internally that I could take all that teaching, that wisdom, and put it into action.”
