their cars to me... I did that for at least 15 years." During that time, Barry married and welcomed two children, one boy and one girl. The marriage ended in divorce. "That was probably about 20 years ago. That's when I started doing the ironwork," he shared. "I'd spend all winter making things—ornamental work like shepherd's hooks and trellises and stuff—and sell them in the spring to places like Drummers and Donahue's. But, then, everyone just quit buying. I think junk from Japan undercut my prices."

Barry then opened Prairiedog Hunting Supply out of his building in Waterville. The business is mostly closed now, due to his health struggles.

"I don't know how much longer I'll be around. I didn't think I'd make it to my birthday this year, but I did," he shared with a weary grin. "I guess it's good I'm telling someone about my service stuff now... I'm sure it's not the story you wanted."
