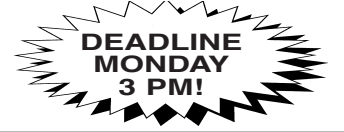

Herbologist talks at spring program

Randy Peck from rural Lonsdale was the guest speaker at the Czech Heritage Club's April program for 24 adults and five children.

Peck, a Herbologist, spoke about the benefits and culinary uses for common plants that grow in our own backyards and local meadows. He has been a "forager" for well over 35 years.

"He spoke about elderberries, elderberry blossoms, nettles, horsetail, rosehips, catnip, lambs quarter, and milkweed, just to name a few," said Club Secretary Jean Keogh. "He also explained mushroom hunting and the different types of edible mushrooms in the area."

Peck's presentation touched on the best time to find these varieties for maximum flavor, as well as cooking methods to bring out the natural flavors. He also provided nettle tea for everyone to sample.

meeting was Jeff King, President of Finance. He said that Cassia was acquiring Praha Village and the senior apartments in Rosemount.

City Administrator Josh Tetzlaff explained while the bond is within the city limits it would not be connected with the city.

Council member Shawn Ryan asked if there was a downside for the city if they approve the bonds. Tetzlaff replied the bonds would not impact the city and won't show up as one of New Prague's bonds. He added that city staff talked to Baker Tilly, the City's Municipal Advisor. Tetzlaff said the City of New Prague allowing a bond from other cities to happen in New Prague was new to both him and Pikal.

According to a memorandum the bond is not to exceed \$48,000,000 and will be loaned to Cassia to acquire Praha Village and the facility in Rosemount.

Council member Bruce Wolf asked if the joint powers agreement had been run by the city's attorney. He added that he would be more comfortable if they had the city attorney look it over. Wolf also asked what would happen to the TIF (Tax Increment Financing) they had with Praha Village, which includes that some of the apartments would be low income residences.

King said they would continue to honor the TIF.

Ryan agreed with Wolf that he wanted their attorney to look over the proposal. He also asked that Cassia pay the legal fees for the process.

Tetzlaff said they could continue the discussion to the council's next meeting or table it.

King said they could work with waiting a few more weeks.

Election Judges

City Planning and Community Development Director Ken Ondich presented a resolution for the appointing of election judges for the May 24 special election. The election is to fill the vacancy created with the death of U.S. Representative Jim Hagedorn on February 18. Ondich said the judges were selected from a pool of election judges trained for the 2020 elections as new training for new judges has not been available. The special election will be held from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. in the community room at the Fitness and Aquatic Center, 410 Central Ave. N.

Police Officer Oath

New Prague Police Officer Kyle Miller was appointed on December 27 and has since completed his field training with the City. Officer Miller took his oath from Mayor Duane Jirik. Attending were members of Miller's family.

Miller was raised in Montgomery and graduated from Montgomery-Lonsdale High School. He received his bachelor's degree in Exercise Science at Winona State University. Miller then joined the Minnesota Army National Guard and served for nine years. He served in several positions including as an analyst for the Ramsey County Sheriff's Office Violent Crime Enforcement Team. It was during this time he decided to become a law enforcement officer. Miller was hired with the Minnesota State Patrol in a program that paid for continuing education to obtain a law enforcement certificate, completing a skills course and successfully passing the Minnesota Police Officer's Standards and Training test.

Adoption of Ordinance 2022-010

ORDINANCE REQUIRING LANDOWNER OR DESIGNATE TO OBTAIN A PERMIT WHEN SEEKING A BUILDING PERMIT AND/OR SEEKING TO CONSTRUCT AN ACCESS DRIVEWAY OR ENTRANCE.

The Board of Supervisors for the Town of Cedar Lake, Scott County, Minnesota, hereby ordains that on the 2nd day of May 2022, the Cedar Lake Township Board of Supervisors adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content of the Ordinance, a brief Summary follows:

- Section 1. Authority.** Identifies the legal authority for the Township to adopt the Ordinance.
- Section 2. Purpose.** Identifies the purpose of the Ordinance.
- Section 3. Definitions.** Defines the terms used in the Ordinance.
- Section 4. Permit Required.** Identifies that a permit from the Township is required for constructing an access driveway or entrance.
- Section 5. Conditions of Permit.** Identifies the conditions of the permit.
- Section 6. Inspection of the work and Fees.** Provides for the inspection of the work and such fees necessary to cover the costs of administration, inspections, mailbox swing away support and install, and to ensure that the work is completed properly.
- Section 7. Indemnification.** Provides for the indemnification of the Township for any negligence on the part of the applicant.
- Section 8. Violation.** Identifies the consequences for violation(s) of this Ordinance.
- Section 9. Separability.** Validity of the Ordinance should a provision be declared invalid.
- Section 10. Effective date.** Identifies the effective date of Ordinance.

The Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately

following its adoption and upon publication. A copy of the Ordinance can be viewed by calling the Cedar Lake Township Clerk at (612) 308-0871.

Dust Control Guidelines established at the March 8, 2022 Lanesburgh Township Annual Meeting requires residents give a three-day notice prior to applying dust control in order for the road crew to blade and prepare the road surface prior to applying dust coating application. Please contact Liz Krocak, Township Clerk at 952-758-4385. It is the owner's responsibility to mark on home site, the start-to-end area of applied dust coating using either a florescent flag or florescent painted lath. If any time between June 1 to October 1, 2022, the road becomes a safety hazard due to wash out, washboard, or conditions deemed dangerous after road inspection, the township reserves the right to blade the affected road, including the area which was dust coated. Any damage, to dust coating, deemed to be the fault of the township, will be prorated.
