Toward Zero Deaths traffic safety stakeholders seek to expand JOYRIDE program to decrease impaired driving in Le Sueur County and will recognize the 2022 JOYRIDE sponsors at a special event on Tuesday, Aug. 23 at 9:30 a.m. at the Le Sueur County Government Center in Le Center.

"The Le Sueur County JOYRIDE program is making a difference to save lives. Le Sueur County JOYRIDE program has delivered over 1,000 impaired people home safely," said Tammy Stewig, Le Sueur County Emergency Management Director.

The recognition event will include Le Sueur County Toward Zero Deaths Safe Roads Coalition, Le Sueur County Sheriff's Office, Minnesota State Patrol, regional traffic safety stakeholders, MnDOT and the Department of Public Safe-

"We are coming together to recognize the JOYRIDE program's success, plans to expand the program in the county, and to acknowledge community-led sponsors who recognized the need to decrease impaired driving and get people home safely," Stewig said.

The South Central Minnesota Regional Toward Zero Deaths program brings area law enforcement, public health educators, engineers, and emergency medical and trauma services together to reduce the number of traffic fatalities and severe injuries to zero in south-central Minnesota.

The 13-county area encompasses Le Sueur, Blue Earth, Brown, Cottonwood, Faribault, Jackson, Martin, Nicollet, Nobles, Rock, Sibley, Waseca, and Watonwan counties.

Did you know?

- Nearly one out of every five deaths on Minnesota roads is drunk driving-related.
- In the last five years (2016 2020), there were 397 drunk driving-related traffic deaths in Minnesota, with 79 deaths in 2020 alone.
- 22,653 motorists were arrested for DWI in 2020, translating to nearly 62 DWI arrests per day in Minnesota.
